Owen Roe is one of Ireland's foremost film, TV and theatre actors. He recently appeared in the role of Scrooge in Jack Thorne's adaptation of A CHRISTMAS CAROL at The Gate Theatre and reprised his award-winning performance of Claudius in the Gate Theatre production of HAMLET at St. Ann's Warehouse, New York.

His extensive theatre credits include numerous productions for the Gate Theatre, such as HAMLET directed by Yaël Farber, GREAT GATSBY directed by Alexander Wright, Michael Colgan's production of Brian Friel's FAITH HEALER, as well as A CHRISTMAS CAROL, THE RED SHOES, CATASTROPHE and FESTEN (directed by Selina Cartmell), Mark Brokaw's production of CAT ON A HOT TIN ROOF, Hugh Leonard's DA and GLENGARRY GLENROSS. His work at the Abbey Theatre includes THE PLOUGH AND THE STARS, directed by Ben Barnes, and the title role in KING LEAR, directed by Selina Cartmell. More recent theatre projects include the role of Odysseus in HECUBA and Boylan in MELT directed by Lynne Parker for Rough Magic, Boss Finley in the Old Vic Theatre's production of SWEET BIRD OF YOUTH, directed by Marianne Elliott; and A TENDER THING, directed by Selina Cartmell at the Project Upstairs.

Recent screen credits include HANDY for RTE, UNDERCOVER for the BBC, the short film WAIT written and directed by Audrey O'Reilly, the role of Count Odo in Season 4 of VIKINGS, Paul Mercier's feature film PURSUIT and PENNY DREADFUL for Showtime. Extended CV available upon request.
