Liz won the award for Best Supporting Actress at The Irish Times Theatre Awards 2019 for her performance in The Abbey & Complex co-production DUBLIN WILL SHOW YOU HOW by Tracy Martin. She is about to appear on stage playing the role of Ella in FROM OUT THE LAND directed by Jack Reardon for Clonmel Junction Arts Festival. Recent theatre credits include COLIC directed by Annabelle Comyn for Dublin Theatre Festival, GUESTS OF THE NATION directed by Pat Kiernan for Corcadorca and THE BORDER GAME directed by Emma Jordan at The Lyric Theatre Belfast. On television she recently filmed the role of Karen in THE VANISHING TRIANGLE directed by Rebecca Johnson for Virgin Media Television.

In 2021 Liz appeared in the first live show after lockdown at The Abbey Theatre ONE GOOD TURN by Una McKeivitt playing the role of Fiona and directed by Emma Jordan. Liz also starred on television playing the role of Nicola alongside Domhnall Gleeson and Brian Gleeson in black comedy FRANK OF IRELAND for Channel 4 and Merman.

Other recent TV credits include THE SOUTH WESTERLIES for Deadpan Pictures playing the role of Derbhla opposite Eileen Walsh. Earlier in 2019 Liz completed filming on BBC/Hulu series NORMAL PEOPLE directed by Lenny Abrahamson and Hettie Macdonald, on the feature HERSELF directed by Phyllida Lloyd and on short film CALVING directed by Louis Bhoose for Agile Films.

On stage Liz has appeared as Lady Macbeth in an Irish Language version of MACBETH for Fínb Theatre Company. Prior to this she completed a National tour reprising the role of Maeve in the stage production REMEMBER TO BREATHE and before that she performed her one-woman show KICKING ALL THE BOXES at The Vaults Festival in London. In January 2019 she completed filming the role of Patricia in REDEMPTION OF A ROGUE: A BLUES OPERA written and directed by Philip Doherty and opposite Aaron Monaghan.

Other recent credits include TÓRÁIOCHT directed by Mikel Murfi for Fínb Theatre Company, Galway, the lead role of Maeve in REMEMBER TO BREATHE directed by Orla Murphy, with performances at the Dublin and Edinburgh Fringe Festivals, the role of Bianca in OTHELLO directed by Joe Dowling at The Abbey Theatre, Dublin and Fishamble's INSIDE THE GPO directed by Jim Culleton, in which she played the role of Min.

Screen credits include the role of Vicky in LITTLE DEVIL, a short film directed by John Andrew O'Rourke, the role of Tina in the RTÉ series TRIVIA directed by Tom Hall, Failsafe Films' TALK IT OUT, the short film LOVE ME directed by Mark Cantan in which she played the leading female role and the role of Emma in the popular RTÉ series FAIR CITY.
